## 25 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 2.6 Permanent: Full Time 1 27 Part Time 0 28 Time-Limited: Full Time Part Time 29 0 30 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 31 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 32 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 33 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 34 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 35 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 36 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 38 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 39 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 40 41 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 42 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 43 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 44 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 45 46 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 47 48 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 49 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 50 51 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 52 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 53 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 54 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 55 56 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 57 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 58 the requirements of this provision are met. 59
