- S. B. No. 3181: Appropriation; Prof. Counselors Licensing Bd.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Professional Counselor
- 8 Licensing Board, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
- 9 board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
- 10 June 30, 2003.....\$ 72,335.00
- 11 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 12 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 14 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 15 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 16 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 18 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 19 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 20 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 21 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 22 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 23 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2002.
