AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

House Bill NO. 522

1 **AMEND** by striking the underlined language on line 21.

2 **AMEND FURTHER** by changing the word "domicile" on line 29 to
3 "residence"

4 **AMEND FURTHER** by deleting the language beginning with the
5 word "The" on line 29 through the period on line 34 and by
6 inserting the following in lieu thereof: "An applicant for an
7 original license may show proof of residence in this state by
8 presenting to the license examiner at least two (2) of the
9 following documents:

10 (i) A utility bill, including telephone service,
11 showing a valid residential address;

12 (ii) A bank statement showing a valid Mississippi
13 address;

14 (iii) An acceptable employer verification, such as
15 an employment identification card, a letter from the employer on
16 its official letterhead or a payroll check or payroll check stub;

17 (iv) An automobile, life or health insurance
18 policy showing a valid Mississippi address;

19 (v) A driver's license issued by the State of
20 Mississippi to a parent, legal guardian or spouse;

21 (vi) A Mississippi motor vehicle registration
22 showing a valid Mississippi address;

23 (vii) An Internal Revenue Service Tax Reporting

24 W-2 Form;

25 (viii) A receipt for personal or real estate taxes
26 paid within the last year showing a valid Mississippi address;

27 (ix) A copy of a residential lease showing a valid
28 Mississippi address; or

29 (x) If the applicant is a student enrolled in a
30 public or private school in Mississippi, a photo student
31 identification and acceptable documentation that the student
32 resides on campus.

33 (c) If an applicant is unable to provide at least two
34 (2) of the documents described in subsection (2) of this section,
35 he may provide one of the documents described in subsection (2) of
36 this section and one of the following documents:

37 (i) The Individual Taxpayer Identification Number
38 (ITIN) issued by the Internal Revenue Service;

39 (ii) Form I-94 issued to the applicant by the
40 United States Immigration and Naturalization Service;

41 (iii) An Employment Authorization Card (EAD)
42 issued to the applicant by the United States Immigration and
43 Naturalization Service;

44 (iv) A Permanent Residence Card issued to the
45 applicant by the United States Immigration and Naturalization
46 Service; or

47 (v) A stamp in a foreign passport issued by the
48 United States Immigration and Naturalization Service showing
49 evidence of lawful admission for permanent residence.

50 (d) The documents described in paragraphs (b) and (c)
51 of this subsection must include the applicant's name or the name
52 of the applicant's spouse, if the applicant has a spouse, or if
53 the applicant is a minor, the name of a parent or legal guardian.
54 These documents must also show the valid residence address of the
55 applicant being used on the application for the Mississippi
56 driver's license."

57 **AMEND FURTHER** line 35 by changing "(c)" to "(e)"

58 **AMEND FURTHER** line 35 by inserting the following after the

59 word "section": ", except as otherwise provided under paragraph
60 (f) of this subsection,"

61 **AMEND FURTHER** by inserting the following after line 37:

62 "(f) An applicant who establishes proof of residence in
63 this state under this subsection and who does not have, or who
64 states that he has never been issued, a social security number,
65 shall not be required to have a social security number in order to
66 be issued a license or permit but shall complete an affidavit,
67 under penalty of perjury, affirming that he has never been issued
68 a social security number."

69 **AMEND FURTHER** the title by inserting the following after the
70 semicolon on line 8: "TO PRESCRIBE THE TYPES OF DOCUMENTS THAT AN
71 APPLICANT FOR A MISSISSIPPI DRIVER'S LICENSE MAY PROVIDE TO THE
72 DRIVER'S LICENSE EXAMINER IN ORDER TO SHOW PROOF OF RESIDENCE; TO
73 PROVIDE THAT THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S
74 LICENSE PRESENT HIS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
75 PUBLIC SAFETY SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE TO A PERSON WHO FILES AN
76 AFFIDAVIT WITH THE DEPARTMENT AFFIRMING THAT HE HAS NEVER BEEN
77 ISSUED A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER;"
