AMENDMENT No. 1 TO AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2189

1 **AMEND** by deleting lines 983 through 993 and inserting the
2 following:

3 "**SECTION 4.** Each person who is employed by, under contract
4 with, or acts as a representative or agent of a drug manufacturer,
5 who sells, markets or promotes, in person within the State of
6 Mississippi, any drug product of that manufacturer that is
7 intended to be used primarily by or for humans, shall register
8 annually with the State Department of Health, and shall pay an
9 annual registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
10 (\$2,500.00) to the department. The registration fee shall be paid
11 by the drug manufacturers on behalf of the persons who are
12 required to pay the fee under this section, and not by the persons
13 themselves. The registration fee shall be deposited into the
14 special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Division
15 of Medicaid, and shall be used by the division for funding any
16 pharmacy benefits management program of the division. If the
17 registration fee required by this section is not paid, the
18 department shall turn over to the office of the Attorney General
19 the collection of the fee by civil action."
