Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

L9	(d) Career and educational counseling;
20	(e) Individual and group counseling (large or small

23	(g) Educational consultations and collaboration with

- 25 (h) Educational and career placement services;
- 26 (i) Follow-up counseling services;
- 27 (j) Conflict resolution; and
- 28 (k) Other counseling duties or other duties as assigned
- 29 by the school principal.
- 30 (3) The State Department of Education may adopt regulations
- 31 regarding the activities of the school guidance counselors which
- 32 are not inconsistent with this section.
- 33 (4) School guidance counselors shall abide by the American
- 34 School Counselor Association Code of Ethics.
- 35 (5) This section will be repealed on July 1, 2004.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
