Pending AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

78 **<u>SECTION 1.</u>** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a member of Lions of Mississippi, upon payment of the road and bridge 79 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 80 81 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 82 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 83 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 84 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a member 85 86 of Lions of Mississippi. The distinctive license tags so issued 87 shall be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of Lions of Mississippi, may prescribe and shall 88 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 89 90 to distinguish each license tag.

91 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 92 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 93 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 94 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 95 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 96 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 97 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional 98 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 99 county general fund.

Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 100 (3) 101 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 102 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 103 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 104 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 105 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 106 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 107 108 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 109 110 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 111 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 112 collector. 113

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

(a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be distributed to Lions Sight Foundation of
Mississippi, Inc.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
reconstruction of highways.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 133 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 134 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 135 136 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 137 138 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 139 140 tag.

(6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 141 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 142 143 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 144 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 145 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 146 deposit in the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 147 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 148 149 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 150 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 151 152 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon 153 154 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 155 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 156 157 and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive 158 159 license tag in recognition of his support for the Mississippi Veterans Monument. The distinctive license tags so issued shall 160 be of such color and design as may be determined finally by the 161 162 State Tax Commission based upon three (3) recommendations presented to the State Tax Commission by the Mississippi Veterans 163 164 Monument Commission, and ranked in order of preference by the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission. 165

166 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 167 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms HR03\SB2501A.1J

prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 168 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 169 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector as 170 171 a processing fee, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of 172 the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be 173 deposited into the county general fund. Distinctive license tags 174 issued under this section shall be issued within forty-five (45) 175 days after application is made. 176

(3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 177 178 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 179 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 180 applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all 181 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a 182 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 183 184 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 185 time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 186 187 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 188 189 license tag, or if the owner sells or transfers the vehicle, he may surrender the license tag to the local county tax collector 190 and receive a certificate of credit toward the purchase of a tag 191 192 on another vehicle as otherwise provided by law. Distinctive license tags issued under this section may be transferred by the 193 194 owner to any other vehicle owned by him upon payment of the regular taxes and fees for a license tag for that vehicle. 195

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
total fees collected under this section from the issuance of
distinctive license tags under this section. The State Treasurer
shall distribute such collections as follows:

(a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee

A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 215 (5) required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 216 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 217 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 218 219 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 220 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 221 222 tag.

(6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 223 224 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 225 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 226 227 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 228 deposit in the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 229 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 230 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 231 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 232

(7) There is established in the State Treasury a special fund which shall consist of monies required to be deposited therein under subsection (4) of this section. Monies in the special fund, upon Legislative appropriation, may be expended by the Mississippi Veterans Monument Commission for the purpose of

performing any of the duties of the commission under Chapter 15 of Title 55, Mississippi Code of 1972. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund.

SECTION 3. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 244 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 245 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 246 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 247 248 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 249 250 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 251 supporter of Mississippi public education. The distinctive 252 license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the 253 254 State Tax Commission, with the advice of the State Board of 255 Education, may prescribe, and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 256 257 tag.

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 258 259 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 260 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 261 262 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 263 264 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 265 266 county general fund.

267 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
268 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license

<u>SECTION 4.</u> There is established in the State Treasury a fund 320 known as the "Mississippi Public Education Support Fund" 321 (hereinafter referred to as "fund"). The fund shall consist of 322 monies required to be deposited therein under Section 3 of Senate 323 324 Bill No. 2501, 2002 Regular Session, and such other monies as the 325 Legislature may authorize or direct to be deposited into the fund. Monies in the fund, upon appropriation by the Legislature, may be 326 327 expended by the Mississippi Department of Education for classroom supplies, instructional materials and equipment, including 328 329 computers and computer software, to be distributed to all school districts in the proportion that the average daily attendance of 330 331 each school district bears to the average daily attendance of all 332 school districts within the state. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the 333 334 State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings 335 on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. 336

337 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) In recognition of the patriotic services 338 rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof, 339 any resident of the state who is on active duty with the Armed 340 Forces of the United States, upon payment of the road and bridge 341 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 342 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup

trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 343 344 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate 345 346 or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces. The distinctive license tags so issued shall 347 348 be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, 349 as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 350

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 351 (2) by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 352 353 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the distinctive license tag shall present proof of their active duty 354 355 membership in the United States Armed Forces to the county tax collector. The application and the additional fee imposed under 356 subsection (3) of this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be 357 retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax 358 Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. 359 360 The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund. 361

362 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license 363 364 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 365 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 366 367 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 368 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the 369 time the original application is made for a distinctive license 370 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 371 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 372 license tag. <u>SECTION 7.</u> (1) In recognition of their patriotic services 485 486 rendered the state and the citizens thereof, any owner of a motor vehicle who is a member of the Mississippi State Guard established 487 488 under Section 33-5-51, upon application and payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees 489 as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 490 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 491 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 492 493 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor vehicle registered in his name identifying the person as a member 494 of the Mississippi State Guard. The distinctive license tags so 495 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax 496 Commission, with the advice of the Mississippi State Guard, may 497 prescribe, shall bear the words "Mississippi State Guard," and 498 499 shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be 500 necessary to distinguish each license tag.

The distinctive license tags authorized in this section 501 (2) 502 shall be prepared by the State Tax Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the several counties of the state in 503 504 the same manner as are other motor vehicle license tags, and the tax collectors shall be entitled to their regular fees for their 505 506 services. Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 507 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the 508 509 distinctive license tags shall present to the tax collector proof of their membership in the Mississippi State Guard by means of a 510 certificate signed by the commanding officer of the applicant on 511 forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or HR03\SB2501A.1J 553 reconstruction of highways.

(5) The distinctive license tags shall be used only upon and for personally or jointly owned private passenger vehicles (including station wagons, recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the name, or jointly in the name, of the member making application therefor, and when so issued to the applicant, shall be used upon the vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license tag normally issued for the vehicle.

(6) The distinctive license tags issued under this section shall not be transferable between motor vehicle owners. If the owner of a vehicle bearing a distinctive license tag sells, trades, exchanges or otherwise disposes of the vehicle, the tag shall be retained by the owner to whom issued and returned by the owner to the tax collector of the county.

2979 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee 2980 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this 2981 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund 2982 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or 2983 reconstruction of highways.

Choose Life Advisory Council, Inc., may establish 2984 (5) 2985 guidelines and criteria for the allocation of funds it receives under this section, including qualifications for those groups, 2986 2987 organizations, associations and other entities that Choose Life Advisory Council, Inc., determines to be eligible to receive 2988 2989 funds. However, funds disbursed to Choose Life Advisory Council, Inc., under this section shall not be used for the purpose of 2990 2991 attempting to influence any legislation or any political campaign 2992 on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

(6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 2993 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 2994 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 2995 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 2996 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) month 2997 and year license decals for each distinctive license tag issued 2998 2999 under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the license tag. 3000

3001 (7) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
3002 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and HR03\SB2501A.1J

3003 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 3004 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 3005 3006 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 3007 3008 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 3009 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 3010

3011 SECTION 40. Section 27-19-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 3012 amended as follows:

3013 27-19-44. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3014 (4) of this section, for any distinctive license tag or plate 3015 authorized by the Legislature from and after July 1, 2000, the requirements of this section must be met before the State Tax 3016 Commission may prepare or issue any such license tag or plate. 3017 The organization or other entity for which the Legislature 3018 3019 authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must submit proof 3020 satisfactory to the State Tax Commission that at least one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates will be purchased and must 3021 3022 deposit with the commission an amount necessary to purchase one hundred (100) of such license tags or plates. The organization or 3023 3024 other entity for which the Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate must satisfy the requirements of this 3025 3026 subsection (1) within two (2) years after the effective date of 3027 the law authorizing the license tag or plate in order to permit 3028 the license tag or plate to be prepared and issued.

3029 (2) If the organization or other entity for which the 3030 Legislature authorized the distinctive license tag or plate meets the requirements of subsection (1) of this section, the State Tax 3031 Commission shall prepare and issue the distinctive license tag or 3032 3033 plate. If the State Tax Commission prepares and issues a 3034 distinctive license tag or plate for the organization or other entity, the commission shall review the number of such license 3035 tags or plates issued during the period for the license tag or 3036 3037 plate series. If the number of distinctive license tags or plates

3038 falls below one hundred (100) in the last year of the series, the 3039 license tag or plate shall be discontinued at the end of the 3040 period for the series.

3041 If a distinctive license tag or plate is discontinued (3)under subsection (2) of this section, the organization or other 3042 3043 entity for which the license tag or plate was discontinued may 3044 prepare a distinctive license tag or plate decal. The distinctive license tag or plate decal shall be of such size, color and design 3045 as may be agreed upon by the organization or other entity and the 3046 3047 State Tax Commission. However, the State Tax Commission shall 3048 have final approval of the size, color and design of the decal. The distinctive license tag or plate decals shall be prepared and 3049 3050 sold by the organization or other entity, and the proceeds derived from the sale of such decals shall be retained by the organization 3051 3052 or other entity for any use deemed appropriate by the organization 3053 or other entity.

3054 (4) The provisions of this section are not applicable to
 3055 distinctive license tags or plates issued under Section 31 of
 3056 Senate Bill No. 2501, 2002 Regular Session, and distinctive
 3057 license tags issued under Section 38 of Senate Bill No. 2501, 2002
 3058 Regular Session.

3059 **SECTION 41.** Section 27-19-56.12, Mississippi Code of 1972, 3060 is amended as follows:

3061 27-19-56.12. In recognition of the patriotic service 3062 rendered by Mississippians who are honorably discharged veterans who served in the United States Armed Forces, any such person is 3063 3064 privileged to obtain distinctive motor vehicle license plates or 3065 tags for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying his status as a veteran. The State Tax Commission, with concurrence 3066 by the State Veterans Affairs Board, shall develop decals to be 3067 3068 affixed to the license tag indicating branch and period of 3069 military service. The distinctive plates or tags shall be of a color and design designated by the Tax Commission with concurrence 3070 by the State Veterans Affairs Board. 3071

3072 The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax HR03\SB2501A.1J

Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the 3073 3074 counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license 3075 plates or tags. An additional annual tag fee of Thirty Dollars 3076 (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license 3077 plates or tags and shall be remitted to the Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The additional fee 3078 3079 is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive tag under this section and thereafter annually 3080 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains 3081 the distinctive license tag. The State Tax Commission shall 3082 3083 deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be administered by the 3084 board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in this state for the 3085 benefit of indigent veterans who are residents of such nursing 3086 homes

An applicant for such distinctive plates shall present to the 3087 issuing official written evidence of the veteran's service. 3088 Such 3089 evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a 3090 Report of Separation from Military Service, a military discharge document, or a written certification of military service from the 3091 3092 State Veterans Affairs Board. The distinctive license plates or 3093 tags so issued shall be used only upon a personally or jointly owned private passenger vehicle (to include station wagons, 3094 recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the 3095 name, or jointly in the name, of the person making application 3096 3097 therefor, and when issued to such person shall be used upon the vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate or 3098 3099 license tag normally issued for such vehicle.

The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable between motor vehicle owners; and in the event the owner of a vehicle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange or otherwise dispose of the vehicle, such plate shall be retained by such owner and returned to the tax collector.

3105 **SECTION 42.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 3106 and after July 1, 2002.
