SECTION 10. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as

the requirements of this provision are met.

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SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 129 130 State Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from 131 132 administrative fees charged and from interest earnings on any funds authorized for administration of the Mississippi Prepaid 133 134 Affordable College Tuition Program, for the administration of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program. 135 funds shall be escalated in accordance with the rules and 136 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 137 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 138 139 SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 154 155 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 156 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 157 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 158 159 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 160 SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 161
