15	authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending			
16	June 30, 2003\$ 145,229,981.00.			
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of			
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall

It shall be the responsibility of the

agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 59 60 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 61 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 62 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 63 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 64 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 65 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 66 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 67 68 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 69 the requirements of this provision are met. 70

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating the state welcome centers.

82 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 83 84 other orders of or agreements involving any agency, 85 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may 86 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the 87 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under 88 89 the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not 90 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved, 91 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and 92 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 93

94 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 95 Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to 96 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 97 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 98 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 99 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 100 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete 101 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 102 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 103 104 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2002. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 105 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be 106 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 107 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 108 provided during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process. 109

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of Four Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$4,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2003. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of One Million Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,067,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2003. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

**SECTION 10.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 165 Executive Director of the Mississippi Development Authority may 166 167 authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 168 169 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 170 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 171 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 172 173 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

174 SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 175 176 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 177 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for the 178 Institute for Technology Development, for the fiscal year 179 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 180 181 500,000.00.

The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for support of the Institute for Technology Development to equip, operate and maintain a post-graduate, integrated circuit design, engineering training program, known as ComPEET. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi Development Authority.

SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein 189 190 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 191 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 192 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for 193 Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning 194 195 July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... .....\$ 850,000.00. 196 197 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 198 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for

199 support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the 200 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and 201 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 202 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi 203 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and 204 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 205 Development Authority.

SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein 206 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 207 208 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 209 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to 210 211 support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 212 June 30, 2003.....\$ 1,250,000.00. 213 The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and 214

215 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 216 Development Authority.

**SECTION 16.** None of the funds appropriated in Section 2 shall be expended unless members of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate representing such districts are notified at least three (3) days prior to the awarding of Community Development Block Grants or any other grants to their districts.

SECTION 17. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal HR05\SB3146A.J Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. **SECTION 18.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.
