61 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 62 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 63 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 64 65 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 66 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 67 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 68 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 69 70 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 71 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 72 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 73 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 74 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 75 76 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 77 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 78 79 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 80 81 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 82 83 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 84 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 85 86 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 87 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 88 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 89 the requirements of this provision are met. 90 91 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 92 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 93 94 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

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- 95 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
  96 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 97 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
  98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
  99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
  100 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 102 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002.
