Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 40 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 42 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 44 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 45 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 46 47 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 48 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 49 50 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 51 52 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 53 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 54 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 55 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 56 57 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 58 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 59 60 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce HR05\SB3153A.J

61 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 62 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 63 the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts, agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

84 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 85 and after July 1, 2002.

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
