## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the general expenses of the operation of the Mississippi National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and 9 ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 10 4,752,665.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National 12 13 Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund--No. 3700, as created by Chapter 187, Laws 14 of 1954, as amended; the Service Contract Fund--No. 3701; the Camp 15 Shelby Base Operations Fund--No. 3705; the Air National Guard 16 Training Site Base Operations Fund--No. 3709; and the Education 17 Enhancement Fund, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions 18 of applicable statutes and federal/state agreements for the fiscal 19 year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 20 \$ 21 51,273,285.00. SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 22 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 23 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 2.4

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 36 37 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 38 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 39 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 40 41 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 42 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 43 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 44 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 45 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 46 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 47 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 48 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 49 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 50 51 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 52 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 53 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 54 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 55 56 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 57 the requirements of this provision are met. 58

59 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with HR05\SB3161A.J

60 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2004 shall be submitted to 67 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 68 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 69 during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request process.

70 SECTION 5. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall be expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the 71 72 provisions of Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. If not needed for other purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby 73 expressly authorized to invest any part of or all monies herein 74 appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund at the highest 75 76 rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing on such 77 investments to the respective fund. Such monies may be invested in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the 78 79 United States of America or the State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of this state, which said county or municipal 80 81 bonds have been approved by a reputable bonds attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court, and in any event the said 82 bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall 83 mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so invested 84 will be needed for the refund or refunds herein provided for. 85

**SECTION 6.** The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds which may become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi National Guard is hereby authorized and approved, provided such expenditures are reported and otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

92 **SECTION 7.** The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 93 which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for 94 construction purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided

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95 such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise handled 96 in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 97 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

98 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 99 Million Eight Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Sixty-four Dollars 100 (\$1,876,064.00) shall be transferred from the State Department of 101 Education to the Mississippi National Guard for the support of the 102 Youth Challenge Program at Camp Shelby.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 103 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 104 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 105 106 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 107 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 108 109 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2002. 110
