165 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, HR05\SB3163A.J

none shall be expended for personnel housing under the 166 167 jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections unless the department shall collect a reasonable rent, after a finding of 168 169 fact as to what is a reasonable rent, and/or the cost of utilities furnished to said housing, except that the Superintendent of the 170 Central Mississippi Correctional Facility may be provided with a 171 housing expense allowance in lieu of being furnished with a 172 dwelling house. The Department of Corrections shall not pay for 173 the installation or monthly service of any telephone installed in 174 175 a staff residence under its jurisdiction. 176 SECTION 7. No part of the funds herein appropriated shall be 181 used for the purpose of returning escaped state convicts to the 182 183 State Penitentiary from a distance of over one hundred (100) miles beyond the borders of the state, except upon approval of the 184 185 Governor in each specific case. SECTION 9. None of the money herein appropriated shall be 186 187 paid to any person who by the provision of Section 47-5-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, is prohibited from being an 188 189 employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. The State 190 Department of Finance and Administration shall at least annually make a report to the Joint Legislative Committee on Performance 191 192 Evaluation and Expenditure Review and to the Attorney General stating the name of any person prohibited under the provisions of 193 Section 47-5-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, from being 194 an employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections who has 195 196 during the preceding year received any money herein appropriated. 197 In the event that any such person prohibited as herein above provided from receiving funds herein appropriated should receive 198 any of said funds, the Attorney General shall immediately commence 199 200 action to recover the monies so paid to said person and to enjoin

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the further employment of said person at the Mississippi 201 202 Department of Corrections. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 203 SECTION 10. 204 Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Corrections may transfer between the divisions of Support, Medical Services, 205 206 Parole Board, Farming Operations, Private Prisons, Regional Facilities and Local Confinement, both funds and positions not to 207 exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the authorized budgets in the 208 aggregate. The Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of 209 Corrections shall submit written justification for the transfer to 210 211 the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to 212 the effective date of the transfer. It is further the intention 213 of the Legislature that no transfer may be made under the 214 provisions of this section to increase or decrease the salaries 215 category of any budget set forth in the original appropriations 216 217 made under this act, but may be used to contract with counties to 218 house state inmates in facilities authorized by Section 47-5-931, Mississippi Code of 1972. It is further the intention of the 219 220 Legislature that any transfers made under the provisions of this paragraph shall be for the removal of state inmates from county 221 222 jails or of an emergency nature. SECTION 11. It is the intent of the Legislature that all 223 prisoners at Parchman shall work a minimum of eight (8) hours per 224 day, excluding prisoners with a physical disability or those 225 incarcerated in maximum security. 226 227 SECTION 12. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 228 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 229 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 230 231 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 232 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 233 performance measures provided below:

This act shall take effect and be in force from 281 282 and after July 1, 2002.
