Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the 8 expenses of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, created by Section 41-29-101 et seq., 9 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003......\$ 9,649,944.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any money 14 in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of 15 Public Safety which is comprised of special source funds collected 16 by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and 17 maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003.....\$ 2,568,825.00. 19 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 2.0 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 21 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 22 23 expenditure:

44	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
45	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
46	equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the
47	Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),
48	whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.
49	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
50	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
51	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
52	Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003
53	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or
54	pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi
55	Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget
56	Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish
57	separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data,
58	for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and
59	January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual
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60 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 61 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 62 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 63 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 64 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 65 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 66 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 67 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 68 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 69 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 70 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 71 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 72 the requirements of this provision are met. 73 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 74 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 75 76 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 78 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 80 SECTION 4. Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 81 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 82 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 83 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 84 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 85 86 performance measures provided below: 87 FY2003 88 <u>Performance Measures</u> <u>Target</u> Drug Enforcement 89 90 Arrests Made (Persons) 2,600 91 Number of Prosecutions (Actions) 2,300 Organizations Disrupted/Dismantled (Actions) 92 135

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets

set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the

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- 95 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
- 96 Committee for Fiscal Year 2004.
- 97 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 98 Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for
- 99 sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One
- 100 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.
- 101 SECTION 6. The Director of the Bureau of Narcotics shall
- 102 have the authority to transfer any funds between any major objects
- 103 of expenditure, including but not limited to Salaries, Wages, and
- 104 Fringe Benefits, up to five percent (5%).
- 105 **SECTION 7.** No funds appropriated herein shall be used for
- 106 the purpose of hiring new agents during Fiscal Year 2003; however,
- 107 funds may be used to employ Mississippi Highway Patrol officers,
- 108 former officers of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics or any law
- 109 enforcement officer as an agent that has successfully completed
- 110 training through a certified law enforcement training academy
- 111 prior to July 1, 2002.
- 112 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the
- 113 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 114 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 115 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 116 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 117 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 118 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 119 and after July 1, 2002.
