## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs
8	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
9	June 30, 2003\$ 2,459,019.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
12	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs
13	Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or
14	otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance
15	of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and
16	ending June 30, 2003\$ 21,232,271.00.
17	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
19	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the

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59 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 60 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 61 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 62 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 63 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 64 65 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 66 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 67 68 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 69 the requirements of this provision are met. 70

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to

indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran 81 surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse 82 was a resident of a state veterans home at the time of the 83 veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's death, meets 84 85 the indigent/low-income criteria established by the State Veterans Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the intention 86 of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of 87 indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such 88 period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current 89 90 surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance 91 Act of 1997." 92

93 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the HR05\SB3166A.J

94 Executive Director of the Veterans Affairs Board may authorize 95 increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 96 exceed five percent (5%) of the appropriated amount of each major 97 object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of 98 expenditure are decreased by the corresponding dollar amount. 99 However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major 100 object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 101 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 102 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 103 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 104 105 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 106 107 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 108 and after July 1, 2002.
