Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

37 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 41 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 42 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 43 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 44 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 45 46 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 47 48 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 49 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 50 51 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 52 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 53 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 54 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 55 56 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 57 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 58 59 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement

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60 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as61 the requirements of this provision are met.

62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. In addition to any other funds appropriated 68 69 herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Unemployment Trust 70 Fund, made available to this state under Section 903 of the Social 71 72 Security Act, as amended, to the Employment Security Commission to be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund for 73 use by the Employment Security Commission, under the direction of 74 the Office of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management to 75 76 acquire lands and construct buildings thereon or improve existing 77 buildings to be used as offices, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... \$ 6,000,000.00. 78

79 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated under the provisions of Section 3 shall be requisitioned by the Employment 80 81 Security Commission from the Unemployment Trust Fund maintained by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States as needed for 82 83 the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and such monies shall be deposited in the Employment Security 84 Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 85 86 71-5-457, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 5. In addition to any other funds appropriated 87 herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 88 is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Special Employment 89 Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission 90 91 for its use as provided in Section 71-5-114, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending 92 June 30, 2003..... \$2,075,000.00. 93 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated under the 94

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95 provisions of Section 5 shall be requisitioned by the Employment 96 Security Commission from the Special Employment Security 97 Administration Fund as needed for the payment of obligations 98 incurred under this appropriation, and such monies requisitioned 99 shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund 100 upon receipt.

SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in this act, a total of 101 Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) is provided for the 102 purpose of constructing and/or lease purchasing a new headquarters 103 facility for the Mississippi Employment Security Commission, and 104 105 paying for any costs associated with the construction of 106 facilities. The funds authorized in this section shall be under the direction of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 107 Management. 108

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 109 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 110 111 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 112 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 113 114 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 115 and after July 1, 2002. 116
