23	SECTION 3. In addition to all other sums previously
24	appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be
25	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Working
26	Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund created in Section 27-103-203,

Mississippi Code of 1972, that is not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Education for the purpose of paying annual compensation to the Chickasaw Cession counties for sixteenth section lands which they lost through sale by the state, as provided in Sections 29-3-137 through 29-3-141, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002......\$ 518,722.00.

SECTION 4. In addition to all other sums previously 34 appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be 35 36 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund created in Section 27-103-203, 37 Mississippi Code of 1972, that is not otherwise appropriated, to 38 the State Department of Education for the purpose of funding the 39 Uniform Millage Assistance Grants Program for the fiscal year 40 ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 1,070,001.00. 41

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums previously appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Department of Education for the purpose of funding the Minimum Education Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002...... \$17,000,000.00.

However, the appropriation in this section is contingent upon 48 the transfer of sufficient funds into the State General Fund under 49 50 Section 27-103-203(4), Mississippi Code of 1972, and the appropriation shall not be made until after the Executive Director 51 of the Department of Finance and Administration has transferred 52 53 the maximum amount that is authorized to be transferred under Section 27-103-203(4), Mississippi Code of 1972, from the Working 54 Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund to the State General Fund during 55 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002. 56

57 SECTION 6. (1) The additional appropriations in Section 1 58 and Section 5 of this act are made for the purpose of restoring 59 cuts made by the Governor on February 11, 2002, to the Minimum 60 Education Program.

61 (2) The additional appropriation in Section 2 of this act is HR05\SB3198A.1J 62 made for the purpose of restoring cuts made by the Governor on63 February 11, 2002, to the Mississippi Adequate Education Program.

(3) The additional appropriation in Section 3 of this act is
made for the purpose of restoring cuts made by the Governor on
February 11, 2002, to the Chickasaw School Fund.

(4) The additional appropriation in Section 4 of this act is
made for the purpose of restoring cuts made by the Governor on
February 11, 2002, to the Uniform Millage Assistance Grants
Program.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that if any funds other than funds appropriated by this act for the Minimum Program, Mississippi Adequate Education and Chickasaw Interest budgets are made available to the State Department of Education, the department shall deposit any and all such funds to the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund.

SECTION 8. The money appropriated by Sections 1 through 4 of 77 78 this act shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund that is not otherwise 79 appropriated, and the money appropriated by Section 5 of this act 80 shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State 81 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by 82 83 the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, 84 85 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

86 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE WORKING 2 CASH-STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND AND THE STATE GENERAL FUND TO THE 3 STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE 4 MINIMUM EDUCATION PROGRAM, THE MISSISSIPPI ADEQUATE EDUCATION 5 PROGRAM AND THE CHICKASAW SCHOOL FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2002.
