AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

House Bill NO. 793

**By Senator(s) Chamberlin, Furniss, Huggins, Jackson,
Simmons**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following segments of highway are
8 designated as state highways and placed under the jurisdiction of
9 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
10 maintenance; and such highways, together with the highways
11 designated in Section 65-3-3 and all other laws adding links to
12 the designated state highway system are declared to be the state
13 highway system of Mississippi:

14 **Southern District - Simpson County:**

15 Mississippi Highway 469 beginning at Harrisville near
16 the old school building, Section 34, Township 2 North,
17 Range 2 East, 7.2 miles north of its intersection with
18 Mississippi Highway 28 at Union, thence .46 miles
19 through Harrisville and ending at the beginning of state
20 maintenance of Mississippi Highway 469 in Section 27,
21 Township 2 North, Range 2 East.

22 **Southern District - Simpson County:**

23 Mississippi Highway 540 beginning at its intersection
24 with Mississippi Highway 541 and extending easterly for
25 a distance of 1077.75 feet.

26 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
27 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
28 the highway segments described under subsection (1) of this
29 section whenever such highway segments have been brought up to
30 commission standards.

31 **SECTION 2.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
32 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
33 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
34 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
35 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
36 the state highway system of Mississippi:

37 **Northern District - Coahoma County:**

38 That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a
39 mile east of the termination of state maintenance of
40 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to
41 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
42 61, and that segment of highway extending westerly from
43 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
44 61 to its intersection with the eastern city limits of
45 Friars Point, Mississippi.

46 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
47 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
48 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
49 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
50 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
51 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
52 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

53 **SECTION 3.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
54 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
55 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
56 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
57 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
58 the state highway system of Mississippi:

59 **Northern District - DeSoto County:**

60 That segment of road beginning at the intersection of

61 Mississippi 301 and Mississippi 304 and extending southerly
62 to Arkabutla Dam.

63 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
64 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
65 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
66 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
67 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
68 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
69 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

70 **SECTION 4.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
71 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
72 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
73 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
74 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
75 the state highway system of Mississippi:

76 **Northern District - Carroll County:**

77 Old Mississippi Highway 430 from the Leflore/Carroll
78 County line southeasterly to its intersection with
79 Mississippi Highway 17, a distance of approximately thirteen
80 (13) miles.

81 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
82 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
83 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
84 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
85 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
86 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
87 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

88 **SECTION 5.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
89 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
90 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
91 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
92 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
93 the state highway system of Mississippi:

94 **Central District - Kemper County:**

95 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi

96 Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.

97 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
98 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
99 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
100 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
101 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
102 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
103 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

104 **SECTION 6.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
105 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
106 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
107 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
108 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
109 the state highway system of Mississippi:

110 **Central District - Bolivar and Sunflower Counties:**

111 A roadway segment beginning at or near Shelby and
112 extending easterly to at or near Parchman.

113 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
114 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
115 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
116 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
117 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
118 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
119 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

120 **SECTION 7.** (1) The following segment of highway is
121 designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of
122 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
123 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
124 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
125 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
126 highway system of Mississippi:

127 **Southern District - Jefferson Davis County:**

128 That portion of Mississippi 42 within the corporate
129 limits of the Town of Prentiss beginning at the end of
130 state maintenance on Mississippi 42 at its intersection

131 with an old abandoned railway and proceeding in a
132 northeasterly direction along Columbia Avenue
133 (Mississippi 42) for approximately seven hundred (700)
134 feet to the intersection of Columbia Avenue (Mississippi
135 42) and Third Street.

136 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
137 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
138 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
139 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
140 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
141 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
142 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

143 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
144 and after July 1, 2002.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAY IN SIMPSON,
2 COAHOMA, DESOTO, CARROLL, KEMPER, BOLIVAR, SUNFLOWER AND JEFFERSON
3 DAVIS COUNTIES AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER
4 THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
5 MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
