## \*\*\*Adopted\*\*\* AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The following segment of highway is 8 designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of 9 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and 10 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways 11 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to 12 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state 13 highway system of Mississippi:

Southern District - Jefferson Davis County: 14 15 That portion of Mississippi 42 within the corporate limits of the Town of Prentiss beginning at the end of 16 state maintenance on Mississippi 42 at its intersection 17 with an old abandoned railway and proceeding in a 18 northeasterly direction along Columbia Avenue 19 (Mississippi 42) for approximately seven hundred (700) 20 feet to the intersection of Columbia Avenue (Mississippi 21 42) and Third Street. 2.2

(2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of

highway has been brought up to commission standards and all 27 28 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated. 29

**SECTION 2.** (1) The following highway is designated as a 30 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 31 32 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding 33 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 34 the state highway system of Mississippi: 35

Northern District - Coahoma County: 36

37 That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a mile east of the termination of state maintenance of 38 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to 39 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 40 61, and that segment of highway extending westerly from 41 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway 42 43 61 to its intersection with the eastern city limits of Friars Point, Mississippi. 44

The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take 45 (2) over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of 46 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this 47 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of 48 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all 49 50 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated. 51

**SECT<u>ION 3.</u>** (1) The following highway is designated as a 52 53 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the 54 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding 55 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 56 57 the state highway system of Mississippi:

58 Northern District - DeSoto County:

That segment of road beginning at the intersection of 59 Mississippi 301 and Mississippi 304 and extending southerly 60 to Arkabutla Dam.

(2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such

69 <u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) The following highway is designated as a 70 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 71 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the 72 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding 73 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 74 the state highway system of Mississippi:

Northern District - Carroll County:

Old Mississippi Highway 430 from the Leflore/Carroll
County line southeasterly to its intersection with
Mississippi Highway 17, a distance of approximately thirteen
(13) miles.

81 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
82 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
83 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
84 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all

87 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The following highway is designated as a 88 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 89 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the 90 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding 91 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 92 the state highway system of Mississippi:

93 Central District - Kemper County:

94 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi

95 Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.

103 <u>SECTION 6.</u> (1) The following highway is designated as a 104 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi 105 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the 106 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding 107 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be 108 the state highway system of Mississippi:

**Central District - Bolivar and Sunflower Counties:** A roadway segment beginning at or near Shelby and

111 extending easterly to at or near Parchman.

(2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of highway has been brought up to commission standards and all utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAYS IN JEFFERSON 2 DAVIS, COAHOMA, DESOTO, CARROLL, KEMPER, BOLIVAR, SUNFLOWER AND 3 SIMPSON COUNTIES AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS 4 UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION 5 COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
