AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 968

By Senator(s) Furniss

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following segment of highway is
8 designated as a state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of
9 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
10 maintenance; and such highway, together with the highways
11 designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding links to
12 the designated state highway system, are declared to be the state
13 highway system of Mississippi:

14 **Southern District - Jefferson Davis County:**

15 That portion of Mississippi 42 within the corporate
16 limits of the Town of Prentiss beginning at the end of
17 state maintenance on Mississippi 42 at its intersection
18 with an old abandoned railway and proceeding in a
19 northeasterly direction along Columbia Avenue
20 (Mississippi 42) for approximately seven hundred (700)
21 feet to the intersection of Columbia Avenue (Mississippi
22 42) and Third Street.

23 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
24 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
25 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
26 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of

27 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
28 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
29 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

30 **SECTION 2.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
31 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
32 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
33 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
34 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
35 the state highway system of Mississippi:

36 **Northern District - Coahoma County:**

37 That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a
38 mile east of the termination of state maintenance of
39 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to
40 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
41 61, and that segment of highway extending westerly from
42 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
43 61 to its intersection with the eastern city limits of
44 Friars Point, Mississippi.

45 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
46 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
47 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
48 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
49 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
50 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
51 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

52 **SECTION 3.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
53 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
54 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
55 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
56 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
57 the state highway system of Mississippi:

58 **Northern District - DeSoto County:**

59 That segment of road beginning at the intersection of
60 Mississippi 301 and Mississippi 304 and extending southerly
61 to Arkabutla Dam.

62 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
63 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
64 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
65 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
66 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
67 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
68 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

69 **SECTION 4.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
70 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
71 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
72 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
73 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
74 the state highway system of Mississippi:

75 **Northern District - Carroll County:**

76 Old Mississippi Highway 430 from the Leflore/Carroll
77 County line southeasterly to its intersection with
78 Mississippi Highway 17, a distance of approximately thirteen
79 (13) miles.

80 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
81 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
82 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
83 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
84 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
85 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
86 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

87 **SECTION 5.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
88 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
89 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
90 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
91 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
92 the state highway system of Mississippi:

93 **Central District - Kemper County:**

94 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi
95 Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.

96 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take

97 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
98 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
99 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
100 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
101 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
102 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

103 **SECTION 6.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
104 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
105 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
106 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
107 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
108 the state highway system of Mississippi:

109 **Central District - Bolivar and Sunflower Counties:**

110 A roadway segment beginning at or near Shelby and
111 extending easterly to at or near Parchman.

112 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
113 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
114 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
115 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
116 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
117 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
118 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

119 **SECTION 7.** (1) The following segments of highway are
120 designated as state highways and placed under the jurisdiction of
121 the Mississippi Transportation Commission for construction and
122 maintenance; and such highways, together with the highways
123 designated in Section 65-3-3 and all other laws adding links to
124 the designated state highway system are declared to be the state
125 highway system of Mississippi:

126 **Southern District - Simpson County:**

127 Mississippi Highway 469 beginning at Harrisville near
128 the old school building, Section 34, Township 2 North,
129 Range 2 East, 7.2 miles north of its intersection with
130 Mississippi Highway 28 at Union, thence .46 miles
131 through Harrisville and ending at the beginning of state

132 maintenance of Mississippi Highway 469 in Section 27,
133 Township 2 North, Range 2 East.

134 **Southern District - Simpson County:**

135 Mississippi Highway 540 beginning at its intersection
136 with Mississippi Highway 541 and extending easterly for
137 a distance of 1077.75 feet.

138 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
139 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
140 the highway segments described under subsection (1) of this
141 section whenever such highway segments have been brought up to
142 commission standards.

143 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
144 and after its passage.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAYS IN JEFFERSON
2 DAVIS, COAHOMA, DESOTO, CARROLL, KEMPER, BOLIVAR, SUNFLOWER AND
3 SIMPSON COUNTIES AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS
4 UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION
5 COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
