SUBSTITUTE 1 FOR AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 974

By Senator(s) Carlton

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

9 SECTION 1. (1) All juveniles shall undergo a screening upon
10 admission to any juvenile detention center, or as soon thereafter
11 as reasonably possible.

12 (2) The screening instrument shall be developed utilizing
13 the Standards for Juvenile Detention Facilities, 3rd Edition,
14 developed by the American Correctional Association in cooperation
15 with the Commission on Accreditation for Corrections. If
16 screening indicates that a juvenile is in need of emergency
17 medical care or mental health intervention services, the detention
18 staff may refer those juveniles to the proper health care facility
19 or mental health service provider for further evaluation, as soon
20 as reasonably possible.

21 (3) The directors of all of the juvenile detention centers
22 shall amend or develop written procedures for admission of
23 juveniles.

24 (4) All juvenile detention centers shall provide or make
25 available the following minimum services and programs:

- 26 (a) A visitation program with parents and guardians;
27 (b) Private communications with visitors and staff;
28 (c) Counseling;

29 (d) Continuous supervision of living units.

30 (5) Programs and professional services may be provided by
31 the detention staff, youth court staff or the staff of the local
32 or state agencies, or those programs and professional services may
33 be provided through contractual arrangements with community
34 agencies.

35 (6) All directors of juvenile detention centers shall amend
36 or develop written procedures to fit the programs and services
37 prescribed by the Department of Human Services.

38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
39 and after July 1, 2002.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR
2 THE JUVENILE DETENTION CENTERS IN THE STATE; TO PROVIDE FOR
3 SCREENING FOR ALL JUVENILES UPON ADMISSION TO JUVENILE DETENTION
4 CENTERS; TO REQUIRE JUVENILE DETENTION CENTERS TO DEVELOP CERTAIN
5 WRITTEN PROCEDURES FOR JUVENILES; TO REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN PROGRAMS
6 SHALL BE PROVIDED AT ALL JUVENILE DETENTION CENTERS; AND FOR
7 RELATED PURPOSES.
