- 68 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 69 Director of the Pearl River Basin Development District shall be
- 70 authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source,
- 71 not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), for the
- 72 purpose of maintaining the Lower Pearl Restoration Project in
- 73 accordance with the Project Cooperation Agreement with the United
- 74 States Army Corps of Engineers and to maintain the South Jackson
- 75 Clearing Project in an area along the Pearl River in Hinds County
- 76 and Rankin County, in accordance with rules and regulations of the
- 77 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 78 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 79 **SECTION 4.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 80 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
- 81 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
- 82 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
- 83 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
- 84 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 85 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 86 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 87 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 88 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with
- 89 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
- 90 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 91 and after July 1, 2002.
