Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 38 Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority be allowed to escalate 39 its budget in the "Capital Outlay: Equipment" major object of 40 expenditure for a crane, with funds from any source not to exceed 41 42 One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00). This escalation shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance 43 44 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 45

46 **SECTION 4.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 47 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 48 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

49 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from50 and after July 1, 2002.

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
