## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special		
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of		
8	Agricultural Aviation, for the purpose of defraying the expenses		
9	of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and		
10	ending June 30, 2003\$ 99,468.00.		
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions		
12	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

18	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation		
19	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase		
20	equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the		
21	Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00),		
22	whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.		
23	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of		
24	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to

make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 25 26 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 27 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 28 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 29 30 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 31 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 32 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 33 34 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 35 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 36 37 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 38 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 39 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 40 41 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 42 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 43 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 44 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 45 46 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 47

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

50 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

54 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 55 State Board of Agricultural Aviation is hereby authorized to 56 accept, budget and expend funds from donations, grants and any 57 special source funds in accordance with rules and regulations of 58 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 59 consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 61 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 62 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 64 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 65 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 67 and after July 1, 2002.
