- 67 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement
- 68 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as
- 69 the requirements of this provision are met.
- 70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 75 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 76 **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 78 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 79 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 81 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 82 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 83 and after July 1, 2002.
