Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

174 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 175 176 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 177 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 178 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 179 180 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 181 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 182 183 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 184 185 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 186 187 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 188 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 189 190 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 191 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 192 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 193 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 194 195 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 196 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 197 198 the requirements of this provision are met.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive 199 200 Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 201 202 positions not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the receiving office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 203 204 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 205 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 206 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of 207 Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month 208 209 prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 210 211 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 212 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 213 in the original appropriations made under this act. 214

215 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 216 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 217 218 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 219 220 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 221 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 222 223 Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 224 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 225\$ 4,000,000.00. 226

SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 227 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 228 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 229 230 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 231 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof. 232 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles

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authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall complywith Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 236 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 237 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 238 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 239 240 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 241 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 242 and after July 1, 2002. 243
