the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 60 61 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 62 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in 63 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 64 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 65 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 66 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 67 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 68 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 69 70 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 71 72 the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance withthe terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

79 SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 80 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 81 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 82 83 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 84 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 85 86 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

87 SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 88 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 89 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 90 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 91 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 92 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 93 Archives and History.

94 **SECTION 6.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part SS05\HB1797A.J

95 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 96 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 97 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

In addition to all other sums herein 99 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 100 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 101 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 102 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and 103 ending June 30, 2003...... \$ 72,111.00.

SECTION 8. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
