55 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 56 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 57 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 58 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 59 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 60 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 61 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 62 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 63 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 64 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 65 66 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with SS05\HB1798A.J

the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 67 68 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 69 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 70 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 71 72 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 73 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 74 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 75 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 76 77 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 78 79 the requirements of this provision are met.

80 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 81 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:

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Training of educators and promotion

of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00 92 93 Miscellaneous grants and programs \$350,000.00 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 94 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars 95 appropriated in the major object of expenditure "Subsidies, Loans 96 and Grants," designated for the "Challenge Program," specific 97 98 amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called the Arts Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts 99 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse 100 101 into the State General Fund and may be expended by the commission SS05\HB1798A.J

in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. 102 Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited to the credit 103 of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission upon 104 appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of the 105 Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts 106 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 107 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of 108 109 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source available not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), that may become available to the Commission in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 117 118 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 119 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 120 121 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 122 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 123 and after July 1, 2002. 124
