6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board of
9	Education for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
10	Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for
11	the Deaf for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending

13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of
16	Education for the support of the Mississippi School for the Blind
17	or the Mississippi School for the Deaf which is comprised of
18	special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the
19	schools, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the schools
20	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending
21	June 30, 2003\$ 968,023.00
22	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
24	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
25	expenditure.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 51 52 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 53 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 54 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 55 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 56 57 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 58 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 59 60 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and

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January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with
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- 63 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
- 64 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases
- 65 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for
- 66 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in
- 67 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any
- 68 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the
- 69 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed
- 70 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal
- 71 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with
- 72 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce
- 73 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement
- 74 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as
- 75 the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 77 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by general law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 79 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 80 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 81 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein provided shall be expended to hire
- 83 any person on a contractual basis, for any period for any purpose,
- 84 without the express prior approval of the State Personnel
- 85 Director. The State Personnel Director shall consider, in
- 86 approving such contracts, the availability of funds, the need for
- 87 services, compliance with the State Compensation Plan and the
- 88 qualifications of the persons offering to perform the services.
- 89 The State Fiscal Officer shall not pay any warrant that is in
- 90 violation of this section.
- 91 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 92 Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for
- 93 the Deaf shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
- 94 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
- $\,$ act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of

- 96 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2002. The Department of
- 97 Finance and Administration shall insure that financial controls
- 98 comparable to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2002 are maintained
- 99 throughout Fiscal Year 2003 for this agency. The State Personnel
- 100 Board shall insure that personnel controls and records comparable
- 101 to those utilized for Fiscal Year 2002 are maintained throughout
- 102 Fiscal Year 2003 for this agency. It is further the intention of
- 103 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 104 2004 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 106 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2003 budget request
- 107 process.
- 108 SECTION 5. With the funds provided herein, it is the
- 109 intention of the Legislature that the academic teachers at the
- 110 Mississippi School for the Deaf and the Mississippi School for the
- 111 Blind shall receive their annual increment.
- 112 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 113 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 114 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 115 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 116 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 117 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 118 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 119 and after July 1, 2002.
