Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 63 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 64 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 65 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 66 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 67 68 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 69 70 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for

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71 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 72 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 73 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 74 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 75 76 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 77 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 78 79 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 80 81 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 82 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
