Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 31 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 32 equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the 33 34 Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 35

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 36 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 40 41 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 42 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 43 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 44 for the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002, and 45 46 January 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003, that project the annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 47 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 48 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 49 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 50 51 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semi-annual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 52 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 53 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 54 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 55 56 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 57 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 58 59 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as SS05\HB1810A.J

60 the requirements of this provision are met.

61 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. In addition to all other sums heretofore 68 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 69 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 70 Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the 71 purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal 72 year ending June 30, 2002......\$ 12,715.00.

This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of providing the spending authority needed for increased contractual training efforts of the State Fire Academy resulting from the September, 2001 terrorist attack in New York City, New York.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from

84 and after July 1, 2002, except for Section 3, which shall take 85 effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
