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SECTION 15. No part of the funds herein appropriated shall

be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of such 241 242 funds be used, either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person 243 244 who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree, computed by the rules of civil law, to the official employing or 245 246 having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the event of any such payment, then the official or person approving 247 and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and 248 severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay 249 into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or 250 251 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General; however, when the relationship is by affinity and the person 252 253 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this provision shall not apply. 254

SECTION 16. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 255 Mississippi State Supreme Court shall charge the maximum amount 256 257 allowable by law for services rendered where charges for such 258 services are provided for by statute, and for any other services rendered, shall charge an amount consistent with the cost of 259 260 providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State 261 Treasury to the credit of the Office of the Mississippi State 262 263 Supreme Court.

SECTION 17. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for the payment of rent for the public space in the Law Library.

267 **SECTION 18.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 268 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 269 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 270 271 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 272 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from 273 274 and after July 1, 2002.
