1 AMEND by striking lines 57 through 75 in their entirety and 2 insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 (7) (a) Any such <u>sale</u>, <u>lease</u>, <u>trade</u>, <u>exchange or other</u> 4 <u>disposition of industrial sites may be made</u>, <u>completed or executed</u> 5 upon such terms and conditions and for such monetary \* \* \* or 6 other consideration as may be found adequate and approved by the 7 authority in orders or resolutions authorizing the same <u>subject to</u> 8 <u>the provisions of paragraphs (b) and (c) of this subsection</u>.

(b) In cases involving the lease of industrial sites, 9 any covenants and obligations of the lessee to make expenditures 10 in determined amounts, and within such time or times, for 11 12 improvements to be erected on the land by such lessee and to 13 conduct thereon industrial operations in such aggregate payroll amounts and for such period of time or times as may be determined 14 by the authority and defined in the transaction documents, and to 15 give preference in employment where practicable to qualified 16 residents of the county, shall, if included in the transaction 17 documents, constitute and be deemed sufficient consideration for 18 the execution of any such transaction document in the absence of a 19 monetary \* \* \* or other considerations. A lease may contain 20 reasonable provisions giving the lessee the right to remove its or 21 his improvements upon termination of the lease. 22

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(c) In cases other than a lease of an industrial site,

any covenants and obligations of the grantee to make expenditures 24 25 in determined amounts, and within such time or times, for 26 improvements to be erected on the land by such grantee and to conduct thereon industrial operations in such aggregate payroll 27 amounts and for such period of time or times as may be determined 28 by the authority and defined in the transaction documents, and to 29 give preference in employment where practicable to qualified 30 residents of the county, shall, if included in the transaction 31 documents, constitute and be deemed sufficient consideration for 32 33 the execution of any such transaction document in the absence of a monetary or other considerations; however, the title to the 34 property shall be transferred by a lease-purchase agreement with 35 36 the stipulation that the conditions included in the transaction documents must be met to the satisfaction of the authority in 37 order for the sale, trade, exchange or other disposition of the 38 industrial site to be finally consummated. 39
