L6	exhaust all leave time earned by that employee, resulting in the
L7	<u>loss of</u> compensation from the state for the employee. <u>Conditions</u>
L8	that are short-term in nature, including, but not limited to,
L9	common illnesses such as influenza and the measles, and common
20	injuries, are not catastrophic. Chronic illnesses or injuries,
21	such as cancer or major surgery, which result in intermittent
22	absences from work and which are long-term in nature and require

long recuperation periods may be considered catastrophic.
