## \*\*\*Adopted\*\*\* AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2501

## By Senator(s) Furniss

1 AMEND by inserting the following after line 1799 and renumber 2 the subsequent sections accordingly:

3 SECTION \*. Section 27-19-56.12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 4 amended as follows:

27-19-56.12. In recognition of the patriotic service 5 6 rendered by Mississippians who are honorably discharged veterans 7 who served in the United States Armed Forces, any such person is privileged to obtain distinctive motor vehicle license plates or 8 tags for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying his 9 status as a veteran. The State Tax Commission, with concurrence 10 by the State Veterans Affairs Board, shall develop decals to be 11 12 affixed to the license tag indicating branch and period of 13 military service. The distinctive plates or tags shall be of a color and design designated by the Tax Commission with concurrence 14 by the State Veterans Affairs Board. 15

The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax 16 17 Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license 18 plates or tags. An additional <u>annual</u> tag fee of Thirty Dollars 19 20 (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license plates or tags and shall be remitted to the Tax Commission on a 21 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The additional fee 22 is due and payable at the time the original application is made 23

for a distinctive tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license tag. The State Tax Commission shall deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be administered by the board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in this state for the benefit of indigent veterans who are residents of such nursing homes.

An applicant for such distinctive plates shall present to the 31 issuing official written evidence of the veteran's service. Such 32 33 evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a Report of Separation from Military Service, a military discharge 34 document, or a written certification of military service from the 35 State Veterans Affairs Board. The distinctive license plates or 36 tags so issued shall be used only upon a personally or jointly 37 owned private passenger vehicle (to include station wagons, 38 recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the 39 40 name, or jointly in the name, of the person making application therefor, and when issued to such person shall be used upon the 41 vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate or 42 license tag normally issued for such vehicle. 43

The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable between motor vehicle owners; and in the event the owner of a vehicle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange or otherwise dispose of the vehicle, such plate shall be retained by such owner and returned to the tax collector.

49 FURTHER amend line 44 of the title by inserting the following 50 before the word "AND":

51 TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE 52 THAT THE ADDITIONAL FEE PAID FOR A DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 53 LICENSE TAG FOR HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES 54 ARMED FORCES MUST BE PAID ANNUALLY UPON RENEWAL REGISTRATION FOR 55 AS LONG AS THE OWNER RETAINS SUCH TAG;
