1	AMEND by inserting the following after line 1573 and
2	renumbering subsequent sections accordingly:
3	SECTION *. (1) The owner of a motor vehicle who is a
4	resident of this state and who has achieved the rank of Eagle
5	Scout in the Boy Scouts of America, upon payment of the road and
6	bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
7	prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
8	trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
9	an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
10	section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor
11	vehicle registered in his name identifying him as an Eagle Scout.
12	The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and
13	design as the State Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist
14	of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
15	distinguish each license tag; however, the Eagle Scout Emblem
16	shall be displayed on the license tag.
17	(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
18	by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
19	prescribed by the State Tax Commission. An applicant for the
20	distinctive tag shall present to the county tax collector such
21	written evidence of the applicant's rank of Eagle Scout as may be
22	considered satisfactory by the State Tax Commission. The
23	application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of

- 24 this section, less Two Dollars (\$2.00) to be retained by the tax
- 25 collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a
- 26 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the
- 27 additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited
- 28 into the county general fund.
- 29 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 30 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 31 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 32 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 33 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 34 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 35 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 36 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 37 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 38 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 39 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 40 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 41 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
- 42 collector.
- 43 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 44 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 45 the State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected
- 46 under this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute
- 47 such collections as follows:
- 48 (a) Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of each additional fee
- 49 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 50 section shall be deposited into the State General Fund.
- 51 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- 52 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 53 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
- 54 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 55 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
- 56 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 57 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 58 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or

- 59 reconstruction of highways.
- 60 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 61 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 62 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 63 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 64 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 65 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 66 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 67 tag.
- 68 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 69 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 70 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 71 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 72 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 73 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 74 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 75 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 76 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 77 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 78 FURTHER amend line 37 of the title by inserting the following
- 79 after the semicolon:
- 80 TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE
- 81 TAGS FOR PERSONS WHO HAVE ACHIEVED THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT IN THE
- 82 BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA;
