1 AMEND by inserting the following section after line 121 and 2 renumbering the succeeding section(s) accordingly:

3 SECTION *. Section 73-35-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 4 amended as follows:

73-35-5. (1) There is hereby created the Mississippi Real 5 Estate Commission. The commission shall consist of five (5) 6 7 persons, to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Each appointee shall have been a resident 8 and citizen of this state for at least six (6) years prior to his 9 appointment, and his vocation for at least five (5) years shall 10 have been that of a real estate broker. One (1) member shall be 11 12 appointed for the term of one (1) year; two (2) members for terms 13 of two (2) years; two (2) members for terms of four (4) years; thereafter, the term of the members of said commission shall be 14 for four (4) years and until their successors are appointed and 15 There shall at no time be more than one (1) commissioner 16 qualify. from any one (1) congressional district of which he is a bona fide 17 resident, as such districts are constituted as of January 1, 1983. 18 Members to fill vacancies shall be appointed by the Governor for 19 20 the unexpired term. The Governor may remove any commissioner for The State of Mississippi shall not be required to furnish 21 cause. office space for such commissioners. The provisions of this 22 section shall not affect persons who are members of the Real 23

Estate Commission as of July 1, 1988. Such members shall serve 24 25 out their respective terms, upon the expiration of which the 26 provisions of this section shall take effect. Nothing provided herein shall be construed as prohibiting the reappointment of any 27 member of the said commission. The members of the commission as 28 constituted on January 1, 2002, whose terms have not expired shall 29 serve the balance of their terms, after which time the membership 30 of the commission shall be appointed as follows: There shall be 31 appointed one (1) member of the commission from each of the four 32 33 (4) Mississippi congressional districts as they currently exist and one (1) from the state at large, and the Governor shall make 34 35 appointments from the congressional district having the smallest number of commission members until the membership includes at 36 least one (1) member from each congressional district as required. 37 No more than one (1) member shall be appointed from the same 38 39 <u>county.</u>

40 (2) The commission shall organize by selecting from its members a chairman, and may do all things necessary and convenient 41 for carrying into effect the provisions of this chapter, and may 42 from time to time promulgate rules and regulations. Each member 43 of the commission shall receive per diem as authorized in Section 44 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, and his actual and necessary 45 expenses incurred in the performance of duties pertaining to his 46 office as authorized in Section 25-3-41, Mississippi Code of 1972. 47

The commission shall adopt a seal by which it shall 48 (3)authenticate its proceedings. Copies of all records and papers in 49 50 the office of the commission, duly certified and authenticated by the seal of said commission, shall be received in evidence in all 51 courts equally and with like effect as the original. All records 52 kept in the office of the commission under authority of this 53 54 chapter shall be open to public inspection except pending 55 investigative files.
