- Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama, in 1992; and 20

- 22 General Peterson was Director, Communications and Information
- 23 Systems, Headquarters Air Combat Command, Langley Air Force Base,
- 24 Virginia; and
- WHEREAS, in this capacity, General Peterson was the 25
- functional leader for 15,000 communications and information 26
- 27 professionals, providing services to over 100,000 active-duty

- 30 WHEREAS, General Peterson also developed policy, oversaw
- 31 programs and managed resources in support of the command's mission
- 32 to provide nuclear forces for the U.S. Strategic Command, theater
- 33 air forces for U.S. Joint Forces Command, U.S. Central Command,
- 34 U.S. Southern Command, U.S. European Command and U.S. Pacific
- 35 Command, as well as defense forces for the North American
- 36 Aerospace Defense Command; and
- 37 WHEREAS, General Peterson directed Air Force communications
- 38 supporting the air war over Serbia and no-fly zone operations over
