- 2 AMANDA MATHIS, THE YOUNGEST PLAYER EVER TO WIN THE MISSISSIPPI
- 3 WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE.
- WHEREAS, on Thursday, June 20, 2002, Amanda Mathis made
- 5 history by becoming the youngest golfer ever to win the
- 6 Mississippi Women's Golf Association Championship Title; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Amanda, 17, defeated Cissye Gallagher in the
- 8 championship match at President Broadwater Golf Club, winning the
- 9 69-year old championship and bringing pride to her hometown,
- 10 Picayune, Mississippi; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the long-hitting Mathis shot the low round (72) in
- 12 the qualifying round and continued her stellar play over the next
- 13 three days, beating Cathy Bailey, 9-time champion Lou Hart and
- 14 Alexis Rather before playing the well-known Gallagher who was
- 15 playing for her 10th MWGA title; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in her championship round, Amanda birdied three of
- 17 her first five holes, was 5-up through six, 4-up through 9, was
- 18 5-up through 12, was about 10-15 yards longer off the tee than her
- 19 challenger, and held off Gallagher at the end after the match was
- 20 twice delayed by bad weather; and
- 21 WHEREAS, earlier this year, Mathis was the medalist in the
- 22 Class 4A State Golf Championship, becoming just the second girl to
- 23 win medalist honors in a high school state championship usually
- 24 won by boys; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Amanda stated that winning the Women's State Amateur
- 26 topped all her previous championships, especially considering she

- 27 beat a player like Cissye Gallagher, a former LSU standout and
- 28 LPGA player; and
- 29 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
- 30 singular accomplishment of this young student athlete, who has
- 31 brought honor to her hometown and to the State of Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 33 MISSISSIPPI; That we do hereby commend and congratulate Picayune
- 34 golfer Amanda Mathis for becoming the youngest golfer ever to win
