- TO HONOR STUDENTS IN 11 UNIVERSITIES THROUGHOUT RUSSIA. 4
- 5 WHEREAS, Dr. Milton Wheeler is Professor at William Carey
- College, a position he has held since 1963. He is a 1961 graduate 6
- of William Carey College and completed both the Master's Degree 7
- and the Ph.D. at Tulane University; and 8
- 9 WHEREAS, at the invitation of Dr. Nikolai Nikandrov,
- President of the Russian Academy of Education and Assistant to 10
- President Vladimir Putin, and the Kindness Foundation of Russia 11
- and the United States, Dr. Wheeler spent 14 weeks teaching 12
- American History to honor students in 11 universities throughout 13
- Russia; and 14
- WHEREAS, the Kindness Foundation estimates that he taught 15
- over 4,000 students in this experience. He also gave seminars on 16
- 17 "Contemporary USA" and "How 911 Changed America." In addition, he
- presented lectures to faculty, to high school students and to 18
- 19 church groups; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Wheeler addressed two conventions: the High 20
- School Leadership Convention in Ivanova and the Student Foreign 21
- Language Convention in Tomsk; and 22
- WHEREAS, Dr. Wheeler is an active Rotarian, having held many 23
- chairmanships and serving on many committees of the district. He 24
- was District Governor of District 6840 in 1989-1990. He is a 25
- 26 member of the Rotary Club of Petal. Rotary International was one
- of the sponsors of Dr. Wheeler's trip to promote world 27

- 28 understanding and goodwill; Dr. Wheeler spoke to Rotary Clubs in
- 29 Moscow, Volgograd, Tomsk and Archangel; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Dr. Wheeler's wife, Donna, accompanied him to
- 31 Russia, and can attest to the far-reaching impact his teaching and
- 32 diplomacy had on the students he encountered; Dr. Wheeler was a
- 33 real promoter of international goodwill and understanding of
- 34 different cultures; and
- 35 WHEREAS, students, faculty and presidents of the universities
- 36 Dr. Wheeler visited presented numerous resolutions of appreciation
- 37 to him, and we join these tributes to this Mississippian who,
- 38 through international diplomacy, ministry and dedication, has
- 39 brought honor to his university, his community and to the State of
- 40 Mississippi:
