AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1

By Representative(s) Committee

1 **AMEND** on line 791 by striking the word "shall" and inserting
2 the word "may" in lieu thereof.

3 **AMEND FURTHER** by inserting the following section after line
4 797 and renumbering subsequent section accordingly:

5 **SECTION 6.** (1) There is established a committee to study
6 and make recommendations to the Legislature concerning the
7 long-term effects of the Nissan plant and the proposed expansion
8 of the Nissan plant and its service and suppliers on the Madison
9 County School District, the Canton Public School District, the
10 Rankin County School District, the Pearl Public School District,
11 the Hinds County School District, the Jackson Public School
12 District, the Clinton Public School District, the Yazoo County
13 School District, the Yazoo City Municipal School District and the
14 Leake County School District. The committee shall make a report
15 of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature before
16 December 15, 2002.

17 (2) The committee shall specifically examine the impact of
18 the new jobs at the Nissan plant and its service and supplier
19 components on the public school instructional staff,
20 administrative staff, school buildings, school bus transportation
21 and infrastructure in Madison County which will be necessary to
22 meet the needs of the additional population created by such new
23 jobs. The committee shall also examine the results of the new
24 Mississippi Adequate Education Funding Formula and its effect on
25 the Madison County public schools as the population of this area
26 increases.

27 (3) The study committee shall be composed of the following
28 twenty (20) members:

29 (a) Three (3) members of the House of Representatives
30 appointed by the Speaker of the House, two (2) of whom shall
31 represent Madison County;

32 (b) Three (3) members of the Senate appointed by the
33 Lieutenant Governor, two (2) of whom shall represent Madison
34 County;

35 (c) The Executive Director of the Central Mississippi
36 Planning and Development District, or his designee;

37 (d) The State Superintendent of Public Education, or
38 his designee;

39 (e) The County Superintendent of Education of Madison
40 County;

41 (f) The Superintendent of the Canton Public School
42 District;

43 (g) The Superintendent of Education of the Rankin
44 County School District;

- 45 (h) The Superintendent of Education of the Pearl Public
46 School District;
47 (i) The Superintendent of Education of the Hinds County
48 School District;
49 (j) The Superintendent of Education of the Jackson
50 Public School District;
51 (k) The Superintendent of Education of the Clinton
52 Public School District;
53 (l) The Superintendent of Education of the Yazoo County
54 School District;
55 (m) The Superintendent of Education of the Yazoo City
56 Municipal School District;
57 (o) The Superintendent of Education of the Leake County
58 School District;
59 (p) The Executive Director of the Mississippi
60 Development Authority, or his designee; and
61 (q) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance
62 and Administration, or his designee.

63 (4) Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after
64 passage of this act. Within fifteen (15) days thereafter, on a
65 day to be designated jointly by the Speaker of the House and the
66 Lieutenant Governor, the study committee shall meet and organize
67 by selecting from its membership a chairman and vice chairman.
68 The vice chairman shall serve as secretary and shall be
69 responsible for keeping all records of the study committee. A
70 majority of the members of the study committee shall constitute a
71 quorum. In the selection of its officers and the adoption of
72 rules, resolutions and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority
73 of the study committee present and voting is required. The
74 committee shall meet upon the call of the chairman, and all
75 members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, and such
76 notices must be mailed at least five (5) days before the date on
77 which a meeting is to be held.

78 (5) Each legislative member of the committee shall be paid
79 from the contingent expense fund of his respective house per diem
80 in the amount authorized by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of
81 1972, and a mileage allowance and an expense allowance in the
82 amount authorized by Section 5-1-47, Mississippi Code of 1972.
83 However, no per diem, mileage allowance or expense allowance may
84 be paid for attending meetings of the committee while the
85 Legislature is in session, and no per diem, mileage allowance or
86 expense allowance may be paid without prior approval of the proper
87 committee in the member's respective house. No study committee
88 member may incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless
89 previously authorized by vote, at a meeting of the study
90 committee, which action must be recorded in the official minutes
91 of the meeting.

92 (6) The study committee may employ consultants or staff and
93 may utilize clerical and legal staff employed by any state agency,
94 school district, political subdivision or municipality of the
95 state, and any other staff assistance made available to the
96 committee.

97 (7) Funding for the study committee may be provided from any
98 funds that may be appropriated by the Legislature for the expenses
99 of the study committee. The study committee may accept money from
100 any source, public or private, to be expended in implementing its
101 duties under this act.

102 (8) Upon presentation of its report to the Legislature
103 before the 2003 Regular Session, the study committee shall be
104 dissolved.

105 **AMEND FURTHER** the title by inserting the following after the
106 semicolon on line 36:

107 TO ESTABLISH A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE LONG-TERM EFFECTS OF
108 THE NISSAN PLANT AND THE PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE NISSAN PLANT
109 AND ITS SERVICE AND SUPPLIERS ON CERTAIN PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS;

110 **AMEND FURTHER** the title on line 30 by striking the word

111 "REQUIRE" and inserting the word "AUTHORIZE" in lieu thereof.
