HOUSE BILL NO. 2

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 133, LAWS OF 2002, TO 1 DELETE THE PROVISION THAT PROHIBITS THE DIVISION OF MEDICAID FROM 2 EXPENDING MORE THAN 25% OF ITS APPROPRIATED FUNDS DURING ANY 3 4 QUARTER OF FISCAL YEAR 2003; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 133, Laws of 2002, is 6 amended as follows: 7 Section 5. 32 * * * In no event shall the Governor's Office - Division of 33 Medicaid make any obligations for medical services which exceed the total level of funds appropriated in this act, and the 34 Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid shall ensure 35 complete compliance with Section 43-13-117, Mississippi Code of 36 1972, by instituting cost containment measures or by discontinuing 37 authorized Medicaid programs to the extent allowed under federal 38 39 law.

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 45 46 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 47 48 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 49 50 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 51 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 52 53 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002, data, for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and 54 January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 55 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 56 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 57 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 58 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 59 60 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 61

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calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 62 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed 63 this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 64 65 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 66 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 67 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 68 the requirements of this provision are met. 69

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

76 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after its passage.
