AN ACT TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 135, LAWS OF 1 2002 (SENATE BILL NO. 3163), WHICH IS THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI 2 3 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003; TO AMEND SECTION 3 4 OF CHAPTER 135, LAWS OF 2002, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF 5 CORRECTIONS SHALL MAINTAIN AND OPERATE THE DELTA CORRECTIONAL 6 FACILITY IN LEFLORE COUNTY DURING FISCAL YEAR 2003 AND MAINTAIN 7 800 OR MORE INMATES IN THAT FACILITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 135, Laws of 2002 (Senate 10 11 Bill No. 3163), is brought forward as follows: Section 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 14 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Department of Corrections for the 15 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003..... 16\$ 233,734,329.00. 17 SECTION 2. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 145 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 146 147 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 148 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 149 150 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 151 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 152 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002 data, 153 154 for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 155 156 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 157 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 158 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 159 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in 160 161 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any 162 calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the

No. 8 023E/HR03/R16 PAGE 5 (RF\LH) agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law, except that no transfers shall be made which reduce funds allocated in Section 3 to Regional Facilities or Private Prisons.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

178 **SECTION 3**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 179 and after its passage.
