HOUSE BILL NO. 2.1

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 11-11-3, 11-11-5, 11-11-7, 11-11-11 1 AND 11-11-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE VENUE IN CIVIL 2
- 3 ACTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 11-11-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, as 5
- amended by House Bill No. 2, Third Extraordinary Session 2002, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 11-11-3. (1) Civil actions of which the circuit court has 8
- original jurisdiction shall be commenced in the court district in 9
- which the defendant resides or in the county where the cause of 10
- action may occur or accrue and, if the defendant is a domestic 11
- corporation, in the court district in which said corporation is 12
- 13 domiciled or in the court district where the cause of action may
- occur or accrue, except where otherwise provided, and except 14
- 15 actions of trespass on land, ejectment and actions for the
- statutory penalty for cutting and boxing trees and firing woods 16
- and actions for the actual value of trees cut which shall be 17
- 18 brought in the court district where the land or some part thereof
- is situated. 19
- (2) Any action against a licensed physician, osteopath, 20
- 21 dentist, nurse, nurse practitioner, physician assistant,
- psychologist, pharmacist, podiatrist, optometrist, chiropractor, 22
- institution for the aged or infirm, hospital or licensed pharmacy, 23
- including any legal entity which may be liable for their acts or 24
- omissions, for malpractice, negligence, error, omission, mistake, 25
- 26 breach of standard of care or the unauthorized rendering of

- 27 professional services shall be brought in the court district in
- 28 which the alleged act or omission occurred.
- 29 (3) If a civil action is brought in an improper court
- 30 district, such action may be transferred to the proper court
- 31 district pursuant to Section 11-11-17.
- 32 SECTION 2. Section 11-11-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 33 amended as follows:
- 34 11-11-5. Actions against any railroad, express, steamboat,
- 35 power, superpower, telegraph or telephone corporation, or against
- 36 individuals owning, managing, operating or controlling a railroad,
- 37 express line or route, steamboat, power, superpower, telephone or
- 38 telegraph line, or against any corporation or individuals owning,
- 39 managing, operating or controlling a motor transportation line for
- 40 the conveyance of passengers, freight or express, for hire, over
- 41 the highways in the State of Mississippi, may be brought in the
- 42 court district where the cause of action accrued or in the court
- 43 district where the defendant has its principal place of
- 44 business * * * at the time that the cause of action accrued.
- 45 **SECTION 3.** Section 11-11-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 46 amended as follows:
- 47 11-11-7. Actions against insurance companies, groups of
- 48 insurance companies or an insurance association may be brought in
- 49 any court district in which a loss may occur, or, if on a life
- 50 policy, in the court district in which the beneficiary resides,
- and process may be sent to any county, to be served as directed by
- 52 law. Such actions may also be brought in the court district where
- 53 the principal place of business of such corporation or company may
- 54 be. In case of a foreign corporation or company, such actions may
- be brought in the $\underline{\text{court district}}$ where service of process may be
- 56 had on an agent of such corporation or company or service of
- 57 process in any suit or action, or any other legal process, may be
- 58 served upon the Insurance Commissioner of the State of
- 59 Mississippi, and such notice will confer jurisdiction on any court

- in any court district in the state where the suit is filed,
- 61 provided the suit is brought in the court district where the loss
- 62 occurred * * *.
- 63 SECTION 4. Section 11-11-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 64 amended as follows:
- 65 11-11-11. Any civil action for the recovery of damages
- 66 brought against a nonresident or the representative of the
- 67 nonresident in the State of Mississippi may be commenced in the
- 68 court district in which the action accrued * * *, except as
- 69 otherwise provided by law.
- 70 SECTION 5. Section 11-11-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 71 amended as follows:
- 72 11-11-13. The venue of an action for damages brought against
- 73 a nonresident arising from his operation, either in person or by
- 74 agent or employee, of a motor vehicle upon any public street,
- 75 road, or highway of this state, or elsewhere in this state, shall
- 76 be * * * in the court district where the cause of action
- 77 accrued or where the plaintiff resides.
- 78 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 79 and after its passage.
