- SECTION 1. In any contract or agreement purporting to settle 5

- negligence, error, omission, mistake or the unauthorized rendering 7
- 8 of professional services of a provider of health care, a clause
- pertaining to confidentiality of the settlement terms or 9
- nondisclosure of the settlement terms shall be void and 10
- unenforceable as contrary to public policy; the remaining terms of 11
- any such agreement not attempting to impose a duty of 12
- 13 confidentiality or nondisclosure on any party shall be enforceable
- if not otherwise violative of law. 14
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 15
