A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING SEPTEMBER AS HEALTHY AGING MONTH.
WHEREAS, the Healthy Aging Campaign has designated September
as "Healthy Aging Month"; and

WHEREAS, the Healthy Aging Campaign is a national ongoing health promotion designed to promote the positive aspects of aging and to provide information and inspiration for adults, age 50 or older, to improve their physical, mental, social and financial fitness; and

9 WHEREAS, a majority of the members of the Mississippi State 10 Senate are also members of the demographic group, age 50 or older, 11 served by the Healthy Aging Campaign; and

12 WHEREAS, many Mississippi citizens are also members of the 13 group, 27% age 50 or older, with 12% of our state's population age 14 65 or older; and

15 WHEREAS, Mississippi's Center for Policy Research and 16 Planning predicts that our state will, in the next 15 years, see 17 age composition shift to an older age structure, with a higher 18 proportion of older people and a higher median age; and

WHEREAS, recognizing that caring for greater numbers of an aging populace may greatly increase future health care costs, the Mississippi Senate shall plan and encourage wellness among older adults by participating in the Healthy Aging Campaign; and
