A RESOLUTION COMMENDING ELDER LARRY WEEMS FOR ELEVEN YEARS OF 1 DEDICATED SERVICE AS PASTOR OF DAVIS TEMPLE CHURCH OF GOD IN 2 CHRIST AND FOR HIS CONTINUING SERVICE TO THE MISSISSIPPI SOUTHERN 3 FIRST ECCLESIASTICAL JURISDICTION OF THE CHURCH OF GOD IN CHRIST. 4 WHEREAS, Elder Larry Weems is the fourth of 12 children born 5 in 1958 to Erenest and Nezzie Lee Weems, Sr. He attended Oak Park 6 Elementary School, Maddox Junior High School and Watkins High 7 School. He was a letterman in both football and basketball in 8 9 Junior High and Senior High School, and he attended Jackson State University on a basketball scholarship majoring in Graphic Arts 10 Design. He was president of a prayer group during his freshman 11 year that had nine students in the group. After four years the 12 membership of the prayer group had grown to over 200 students. He 13 served as Vice President of the COGIC Club at Jackson State for 14 three years. Elder Weems graduated from Laurel Baptist Seminary 15 in 1976 with an Associate Degree and from Jackson State University 16 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in 1980; and 17 WHEREAS, at the age of 11, Elder Weems joined the Sweet 18 19 Buelah Church of God in Christ. He received the baptism of the Holy Ghost at the age of 14 and was appointed Deacon and Sunday 20 School Superintendent at that time. He accepted the call into the 21 ministry at the age of 15. He was appointed President of the 22 Jurisdictional Young Men's Christian Council (YMCC) at the age of 23 19. At the age of 21, he was appointed Jurisdictional 24 Correspondence Secretary, and is currently serving as Secretary of 25

the Mississippi Southern First Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of the

Church of God in Christ; and

35	Mississippi for WLBT Channel 3 for nine years. In 1988, he was
36	appointed Administrative Coordinator for Saints Academy, and
37	continues to serve in this position. He works in the financial
38	office for the National Church of God in Christ under Bishop Frank
39	White and is National Overseer/Treasurer for the Adjective
40	Department; and
41	WHEREAS, Elder Weems is married to Ann Tillman Weems of
42	Clarksdale, Mississippi, and they are the proud parents of one
43	daughter, Vickie, and two sons, Larry, Jr., and Cameron; and
44	WHEREAS, additionally, Elder Weeks is active in the
45	Washington's Addition Neighborhood Association and the West
46	Central Jackson Community. He was selected this year (2002) to
47	serve on Jackson State University's e-City Faith Based Committee,
48	and was later elected Chair. During this time, Pastor Weems has
49	rendered invaluable service to e-City and the Development of the
50	West Jackson Community; and
51	WHEREAS, Elder Weems is committed to the revitalization and
52	redevelopment of the West Jackson area to benefit neighborhood
53	residents. He continues to work diligently to increase services
54	for the elderly and the disabled, to improve and create affordable
55	housing, provide adequate transportation, create jobs, improve
56	economic conditions and provide educational enhancement
57	opportunities for the youth; and
