## HOUSE BILL NO. 29

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-31-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SHALL 2 LOCATE, DESIGN, CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A HOSPITALITY STATION AT A CERTAIN LOCATION ALONG U.S. HIGHWAY 98 IN GEORGE 3 4 COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 65-31-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 (1) The Mississippi Transportation Commission is 9 65-31-1. hereby authorized to locate, design, construct, operate, and 10

maintain hospitality stations on trunkline highways at or near 11 points of entry into this state from other states. Subject to the 12 availability of federal, state or local funds, or funds from any 13 14 other source, the Mississippi Transportation Commission shall locate, design, construct, operate and maintain a hospitality 15 station in George County on or along U.S. Highway 98 approximately 16 eleven (11) miles west of the Mississippi/Alabama state line. 17 In carrying out the provisions of this chapter, the commission shall 18 19 have authority to employ such engineers, architects, skilled and unskilled labor as may be determined necessary by the commission, 20 for the preparation of plans for such hospitality stations and 21 22 their proper location, design, construction, maintenance, and 23 operation. The commission also may employ full-time security officers, as authorized under Section 65-1-131, and/or may 24 contract for the employment of private security officers, as 25 authorized under Section 65-1-136, to patrol and protect the 26 27 property of hospitality stations and visitors, patrons and other employees of hospitality stations. 28

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(2) Prior to the location of such hospitality stations the 29 commission shall afford the opportunity for a public hearing in 30 the county wherein such hospitality station is to be located for 31 32 the purpose of receiving testimony regarding the most feasible and 33 advantageous location for such hospitality station, at which hearing all interested persons may appear and present testimony in 34 regard thereto. A notice of such proposed location shall be given 35 in some newspaper published or having general circulation in the 36 county wherein such hospitality station is proposed to be located. 37 Should a public hearing be requested thereon, notice by 38 publication shall be given at least ten (10) days prior to the 39 date upon which public hearing is to be held and written notice 40 thereof shall likewise be given, within said time, to the 41 governing authorities of all municipalities within such county and 42 the governing authority of such county. 43

44 <u>(3)</u> Each hospitality station constructed under the 45 provisions of this chapter shall be maintained and kept in a neat 46 and attractive condition.

47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after July 1, 2003.
