## HOUSE BILL NO. 52

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPLAY OF THE TEN COMMANDMENTS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** The governing authorities of every political subdivision in the state are authorized, in their discretion, to display the Ten Commandments on an appropriately framed background in any public building.

8 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 9 and after July 1, 2003.
