133	SECTION 2. Section 25-3-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
134	amended as follows:
135	25-3-39. (1) No public officer, public employee,
136	administrator, or executive head of any arm or agency of the
137	state, in the executive branch of government, shall be paid a
138	salary or compensation, directly or indirectly, in excess of the
139	salary fixed in Section 25-3-31 for the Governor. All academic
140	officials, members of the teaching staffs and employees of the
141	state institutions of higher learning, the State Board for
142	Community and Junior Colleges, and community and junior colleges,
143	and licensed physicians who are public employees, shall be exempt
144	from this subsection. In addition, the Executive Director of the
145	Department of Economic and Community Development and the Chief of
146	Staff of the Governor's Office shall be exempt from this
147	subsection. The Governor shall fix the annual salary of the
148	Executive Director of the Department of Economic and Community
149	Development and the annual salary of the Chief of Staff of the
150	Governor's Office, which salaries shall be completely paid by the
151	state and may not be supplemented with any funds from any source,
152	including federal or private funds. Provided, however, that the
153	salary of the Executive Director of the Department of Economic and
154	Community Development and the Governor's Chief of Staff shall not
155	be greater than fifty percent (50%) in excess of the salary of the
156	Governor. Furthermore, all professional employees of the
157	Department of Mental Health shall be exempt from this subsection.
158	(2) No public officer, employee or administrator shall be
159	paid a salary or compensation, directly or indirectly, in excess
160	of the salary of the executive head of the state agency or

- 162 based upon its findings of fact, may exempt physicians and
