## HOUSE BILL NO. 102

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-69, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 RESTRICT THE LIST OF PROFESSIONALS WITH WHOM A COUNTY BOARD OF 2 3 SUPERVISORS MAY CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 19-3-69. (1) The board of supervisors of each county may, 8 9 in its discretion, contract with certain professionals when the board determines that such professional services are necessary and 10 in the best interest of the county. 11 The board of supervisors shall spread upon its minutes its 12 finding that the professional services are necessary and in the 13 best interest of the county. The contract for professional 14 services shall be approved by the attorney for the board of 15 supervisors and made a part of the minutes. 16 A professional within the meaning of this section shall be 17 limited to: 18 (a) Attorneys at law, admitted to practice law in this 19 state by the State Board of Bar Admissions; 20 (b) Accountants, certified by the State Board of Public 21 22 Accountancy; 23 (C) Architects, licensed by the State Board of Architecture; 24 Engineers, registered by the State Board of 25 (d) 26 Registration for Professional Engineers; Physicians, licensed by the State Board of Medical 27 (e) 28 Licensure; H. Appraisers, licensed by the Mississippi Real Estate 29 (f) Commission or as otherwise provided by law; 30 Real estate brokers, licensed by the Mississippi 31 (q) 32 Real Estate Commission; 33 (h) In the sale of personal property pursuant to the provisions of Section 19-7-5, auctioneers who meet standards 34 established by the State Department of Audit. 35 (2) The list of professionals with whom a county board of 36 supervisors may contract under subsection (1) of this section is 37 exclusive, and a board of supervisors may not contract with any 38 39 professional except a professional listed in subsection (1) of 40 this section. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2003. 42
